Three-day school designed for the new hire or salesman. Basics of air compressor technologies and theories are covered.

- Terminology and principles of operation of air compressors, focusing on rotary screw units.
- Component purpose, function and maintenance of standard SPM Series, D, DG, UD & SP series including shaft seals.
- Proper maintenance procedures of the compressor unit.
- Control set up and adjustment for non-MPC and MPC units.
- Reading and understanding of schematics for air/oil, control and electrical.
- Proper compressor installation.
- Lubricants and oil sampling.
- Warranty

Three-day school which picks up where the basic school ends. Included is an in-depth look into the workings and relationship of a compressor's components and systems covering – Standard (D, UD, & SP series), VFD (Yaskawa), and Microprocessors (T1 & Q1)

- Programming and set up of MPC and VFD Drive
- Troubleshooting – emphasis on VFD and Micro-Processor interactions

- Reading and understanding of schematics for air/oil, control and electrical.
- Troubleshooting and repairing problems with the air compressor systems.
- Proper setting of the air control system and motor throttle for efficient operation.
- Training on the use and retrieval of information from the electronic controllers on IT4 and T4 engines.
